REFLEX OCTOBER REWARDS WITH AUSTRALIAN PAPER Terms and Conditions

1. The Reflex October Rewards Promotion (the **Promotion**) is conducted by Paper Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 63 061 583 533) of 307 Ferntree Gully Road, Mt. Waverley VIC 3149 (the **Promoter**).
2. Information regarding EFTPOS gift cards and how to receive EFTPOS gift cards forms part of these Terms and Conditions. By entering, Eligible Partners accept these Terms and Conditions.
3. Entry is open only to Australian Paper selected eligible partners as advised by the Promoter (the **Eligible Partners**). The individual purchasing the Eligible Products must be an authorised representative of the Eligible Partner. The authorised representative must notify the Eligible Partner if an EFTPOS gift card is issued.
4. The Promotion begins at 12.01am (AEST) on 01/10/2017 and closes at 11.59pm (AEDT) on 31/10/2017 (the **Promotion Period**).
5. To enter, Eligible Partners must, during the Promotion Period:
 - (a) Purchase a minimum of one (1) pallet of Eligible Product in the one transaction.
 - (b) Eligible Products are:
 - Reflex Ultra White A4 80gsm Copy Paper (Product Code 161000)
 - Reflex Ultra White A4 80gsm Unwrapped (Product Code 161008)
 - Reflex A4 50% Recycled 80gsm Copy Paper (Product Code 103566)
 - Reflex A4 100% Recycled 80gsm Copy Paper (Product Code 103599)
6. One (1) pallet is equivalent to 80 Cartons (400 Reams) of A4 80gsm office paper.
7. Each pallet purchased must be comprised of only one of the Eligible Products. For example, an Eligible Partner would need to purchase one (1) pallet of Reflex Ultra White A4 80gsm to be eligible to redeem an EFTPOS gift card. The Eligible Partner would not be eligible if the Eligible Partner purchases one half (1/2) pallet of two different Eligible Products to make up one (1) full pallet.
8. Subject to clause 7, for each pallet purchased during the Promotion Period, the Eligible Partner will receive a \$100 EFTPOS gift card. For example, if the Eligible Partner purchases three (3) pallets, the Eligible Partner will be eligible to redeem three (3) \$100 EFTPOS gift cards.

 11. EFTPOS gift cards may be used to purchase goods or services at retailers in Australia.

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13. The EFTPOS gift card Issuers are solely responsible for the fulfillment of the terms and conditions of their respective EFTPOS gift cards.

ADDITIONAL

14. EFTPOS Gift Cards will be distributed by 31st December 2017.
 15. The EFTPOS gift cards are not exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
 16. The Promoter is not liable for any delay or damage in delivery of the EFTPOS gift cards, or for lost, defaced or stolen EFTPOS gift cards.
 17. Eligible Partners and their authorised representative can only enter in their own name and may be required to provide other information, such as their company's name, at the Promoter's discretion. The Promoter may also require Eligible Partners to provide proof of identity, proof of age, proof of residency and proof of email address. Identification considered suitable for verification is at the Promoter's discretion.
 18. The Promoter may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any Eligible Partner from, and prohibit further participation in this Promotion by, any person who:
 - a. fails to produce information or items as required by clause 15 or produces information or items that, in the Promoter's reasonable opinion, are illegible, stolen, forged reconstructed altered, incomplete or tampered with in any way;

 20. Without limiting the previous paragraph, the Promoter Entities will not be liable for any damage, loss or delay suffered by any person in respect of prize fulfillment.

If for any reason any aspect of this Promotion is disrupted, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion, or invalidate any affected entries.
 23. All entries will be the property of the Promoter. The information Eligible Partners provide will be used by the Promoter for the purpose of conducting this Promotion. By entering this Promotion, Eligible Partners consent to the storage of their personal information on the Promoter's database and the Promoter may use this information for future Promotion and marketing purposes regarding its products, including contacting the Eligible Partner via electronic messaging. By entering this Promotion, Eligible Partners consent to receiving SMS or email messages from the Promoter. The Promoter is bound by the Australian Privacy Principles in the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).
